Here we are again The Lord has made it clear that he wants the Easter Triumph to continue proclaiming His gospel mission to everyone. We look forward to the day of His coming. His wish is that nobody is to be left out!

Many of you have been asking that we bring the Easter Triumph closer to the Austin area for everyone's convenience. Well, You got it! Through a supernatural series of events, divinely orchestrated by our Heavenly Father, we will be performing at **Concordia High School (CHS)**, at 1201 South Heatherwilde Blvd in Pflugerville. The staff at CHS have been working very hard to assist us in our location.

This year will be different, but not impossible. For those of you who have been with us throughout the years, we will be performing without a curtain, similar to the set at Burger Center. All the scenes will be on an elevated surface in a stationary position, so that the performing participants can move from station to station, as we proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ through sight and sound. Although the work load for the stage crew will increase prior to the performances, their work will decrease once we begin the actual performances. A crucial key for the stage crew is that we have as many participants as possible to decorate different scenes quickly, while the audience's attention is directed by lights to another place on the stage.

A huge benefit of partnering with Concordia High School in this endeavor will be that all the potlucks, rehearsals, and performances can be held at one location. Unless cast and crew can come to an agreement to select different venues for rehearsal for different time periods but you need to tell the board members what works best for you. (Please see the rehearsal schedule in this newsletter.) The script has been slightly changed for the new set and has been approved by the board. We have also approved the rehearsal schedule, which was streamlined for efficiency and reduction of rehearsal time, we will work with your schedule. We will ask that most parts attend 2-3 rehearsals and the dress rehearsals and performance day.

Now, our need is for participants to make this happen in order to fulfill the Great Commission of proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ to a brand new community. Please prayerfully consider being a part of the Easter Triumph this year.
